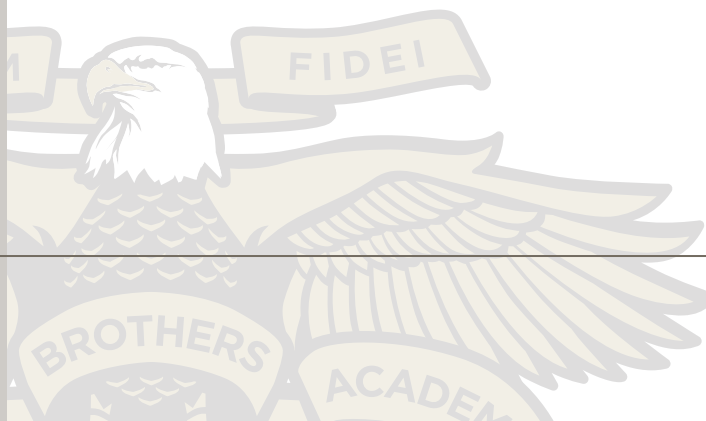
BOB BURNS NAMED VARSITY FOOTBALL COACH

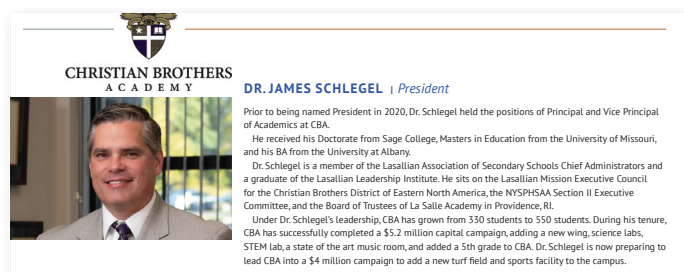

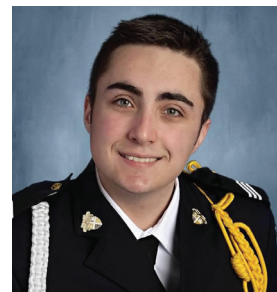


"SOUPER BOWL" COMPETITION

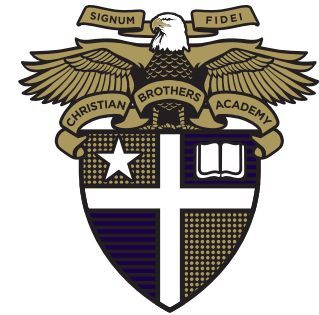


TURF FIELD PHASE ONE

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN



Dear CBA Friends and Family,

This summer seems extra special for us, as we begin to return to our normal routines, including traveling and meeting in larger groups for special events. It also signifies the end of a very special school year, in which everyone in the school pulled together to provide the best possible educational experience for our students, despite the many restrictions in place. CBA managed to provide in person classes to every student, who was comfortable with that choice and, at the same time, provide remote learning for



students who needed that option on a semester or short-term basis, due to quarantine events. In addition, sports, music and other co-curricular activities continued, albeit, with some modifications.

Logistically and practically, to make all of this happen on such a successful basis, every teacher and administrator had to modify their daily routines and come up with innovative

ways to ensure that every student received the highest quality educational experience possible. The amount of planning and time that went into this process cannot be overstated. The Board of Trustee has recognized the tremendous effort put forth by teachers and administration. As a Board, we would also like to recognize the special work of Dr. James Schlegel, who navigated the school through an endless stream of fluctuating rules and regulations, put out by the state and local school districts. In addition, Todd Johnson is to be saluted for the pivotal role he played, as COVID Coordinator, by setting up and administering various systems and protocols to ensure that the school was compliant with the new rules and safe for all those on campus. I personally know families in several different school districts. The experiences their children had, in those school districts, varied greatly from what CBA was able to provide. Finally, we must recognize the students and their families, who adjusted to the new way that the school had to

function and embraced the challenges that it presented. By doing this, the students were able to experience as close to a “normal” school year as possible, and in some respects, it may have been better than “normal”.

The last year and a half has probably been the most challenging period in our lifetime. Through it all, however, the CBA community has continued to support the school and everything it stands for. CBA has held true to its mission, which began over 160 years ago, in a small school in Albany NY. Today, the students, family, alumni and friends of CBA recognize the benefit of a single gender educational environment and show their support in ways that makes CBA successful. Our enrollment held strong at 550 students this year and we are on track to open next year with 560 students. Financially, donors continue to want to invest in the future of CBA and this is evident by the remaking of the stadium, including the installation of a turf field, which will be ready for the start of school this September.

There still are many unknowns about how COVID will affect the next school year. These things we cannot control. What we can do, as part of the CBA family, is to continue supporting our mission.
