MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear CBA Family,

At the close of another successful school year, I am pleased to report on the great work being done at Christian Brothers Academy. During the last few months of school, several traditions and ceremonies celebrate our graduating seniors and turn the school over to our rising seniors. Through Graduation, Mother's Review, and Commissioning, a new class of officers ascends to the leadership positions in our school while the Class of 2023 transitions from students to become the 160th class of CBA Alumni. Our senior class, which earned more than \$19 million dollars in college scholarships, was led by our Valedictorian, Noah Ryan, who will attend Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, and our Salutatorian, Jaideep Saran, who will attend Siena College in the Albany Medical College program. The 77 graduates will leave CBA to attend some of the finest colleges and universities in the country. Our graduating Cadet Colonel, Michael Vogel, turned the brigade over to the Class of 2024 as



he heads off to the United States Military Academy at West Point. Michael leaves the brigade in the hands of a newly commissioned group of cadet officers and the new Brigade Commander, Cadet Colonel George O'Leary.

Many awards that we present to seniors during the graduation ceremony are named after people for their contributions to Christian Brothers Academy. This year, we named two awards in honor of men for their exemplary dedication, leadership, and service to the young men of CBA. The Diligence Award recognizes a senior who has worked tirelessly over his four years of high school to be the best student he can be. This year, the award was renamed in honor of CBA's longest tenured principal (1981-1993) and the Salutatorian of the CBA Class of 1955, Brother William Martin. The CBA Scholar Athlete Award was renamed in honor of an educator who has been responsible for more academic and athletic success than anyone in the history of CBA, in a career that has spanned six decades as a teacher, counselor, administrator, and a coach. He is second in victories as varsity baseball coach, he is the all-time leader in varsity basketball coaching victories, and no one in the history of CBA has more combined victories in all sports; as

a teacher, counselor, administrator, and a coach. Beginning with the Class of 2023, the CBA Scholar Athlete Award will be known as the David S. Doemel '71 Scholar Athlete Award.

The strength of Christian Brothers Academy is our community, but none of the success we enjoy would be possible without the leadership of our Board of Trustees. Under the last decade, we have seen a 75% increase in enrollment, two successful capital campaigns, and expansion and enhancements to our buildings and campus. This June, **Chris Scaringe '82** and **Todd Mesick '85**, completed their terms as Chair and Vice Chair, respectively. Like all private schools, we faced significant challenges over the past fifteen years and many area schools have closed, merged, or had to make fundamental changes to survive. Under the leadership of Chris and Todd, CBA has not simply survived, we have thrived, without compromise, to stand alone as the premier school for young men in the Capital District. This June, our board elected **Will Anthony '81** and **Maureen O'Brien P'22**, to serve as Chair and Vice Chair, respectively. Additionally, we welcomed new members, **Colleen O'Hara P'18** and **Dr. Jared Roberts P'23**. The board and the school have never been stronger and we look forward to continuing the stalwart and intrepid leadership, while remaining faithful to both the Lasallian Education Mission and the traditions of Christian Brothers Academy.

Last September, we opened with 554 students, our largest opening enrollment since 1950. This year, we will continue our growth and welcome more than 575 students to our beautiful campus. The demand for enrollment has never been greater and families throughout the area want this learning environment for their sons. Our focus is on continuous improvement to help each one of our young men reach his potential as a student, to apply his gifts and talents in our programs of excellence, and develop into the person he is called to be. We are blessed to have such a united community, with undying love for CBA, who have proven that we have their support. With the strength of the CBA family, I am confident that we will accomplish our goals.

I wish you a wonderful summer and thank you for everything you do in support of Christian Brothers Academy.

CBA WELCOMES RENOWNED TROMBONIST & COMPOSER

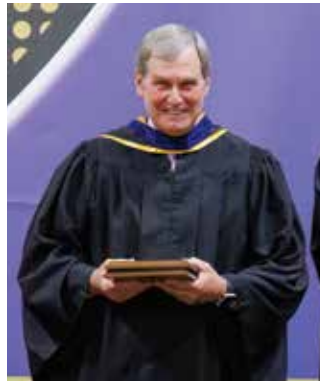
On April 4th, CBA welcomed trombonist and composer, Michael Davis to campus. Davis is a world-renowned artist best known for touring with the Rolling Stones and recording extensively with Frank Sinatra. He has worked with many top artists including James Taylor, Michael Jackson, Bob Dylan, Aerosmith and scores of others. Davis has released 11 solo albums, composed over 150 works, and authored a dozen books for brass players at all levels.

CBA invited Davis to work one-on-one with student musicians during a trombone clinic. The 10 CBA trombonists, from grades 5 through 12, got to experience several small trombone ensembles where they focused on fundamentals. Davis was also able to coach and conduct the Wind Ensemble's Trombone Quartet on two of his original works.

Later that evening, Davis joined the CBA band at the Senior Night Spring Concert at the Clark Auditorium at The NYS Museum, where he was a guest conductor and guest trombonist.

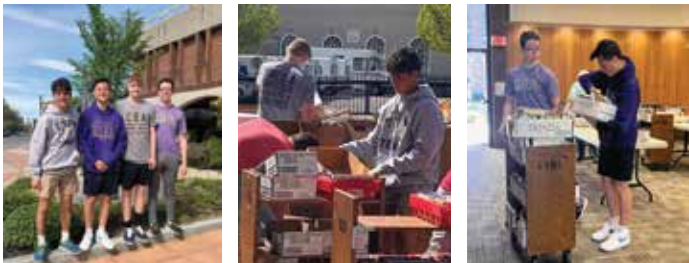


VETERAN WREATH RETIREMENT

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Dear CBA Family and Friends,

On June 30, 2023, I completed my last term as Chairman of the Board of Trustees. It has truly been a privilege and honor to serve in this position since 2010. Over that time, CBA has grown into the strongest private Catholic school in the area. Enrollment grew from 330 students to a projected enrollment of 570 next year; a 100% increase! Physically, the campus has blossomed. A new Arts and Science wing was added, including a spacious musical rehearsal room. A new STEM lab was added, and all five science labs were completely renovated, along with the lecture hall. Recently, the school invested nearly \$1 million in computer technology, by installing new smart technology in every classroom and providing every student with their own ChromeBook. CBA's athletic facilities have been completely transformed, with the installation of a turf field and the construction of a 68,000 square foot sports dome, which is scheduled to open this Fall. Once open, the dome will provide CBA students with an unparalleled experience. None of these accomplishments would be possible without the dedication and generosity of the CBA community of teachers, administrators, students, parents, alumni and friends. I cannot thank everyone enough.

During my tenure as Chairman, I saw the tremendous impact that the administration and faculty had on the growth and transformation of CBA. In particular, I worked closely with Dr. Schlegel, whose leadership and foresight has led CBA along this incredible journey. Without Dr. Schlegel's unwavering commitment to the mission of the Christian Brothers and his aspiration of making CBA the best educational experience for young men in the Capital District, CBA would not be where it is today. Along with Dr. Schlegel, there are other members of the administration that I and the Board have worked closely with and who are a large part of CBA's success. Colleen Ward (Director of Institutional Advancement), Brian O'Connell (Director of Admissions), Vicki Roberts (CFO), and Tom Palombo (Director of Buildings and Grounds), have all played key roles in



the school's transformation. Finally, I would like to thank all the Trustees that have served on the Board over these many years. They helped guide the school along the way and have devoted their time and treasure, above and beyond all expectations.

The Board has elected William Anthony '81, as Chair and Maureen O'Brien as Vice-Chair. Will and Maureen are current Trustees and will be excellent leaders, as CBA continues to pursue its goals of mission and dedication to excellence. I am also proud to say that Maureen is the first female officer elected to the Board.

At our final Board meeting in June, the Board amended the By-Laws to add a new Lifetime category of Trustees. A Lifetime Trustee is defined as, "an individual who has demonstrated the qualities of: talent, loyalty, embodiment of the values of St. John Baptist de La Salle and of the Christian Brothers, who shall have rendered significant service as an elected Trustee." I am honored to announce that Brother William Martin FSC '55 has been elected as CBA's first Lifetime Trustee. Brother William was the Cadet Colonel, class of 1955 and served as Principal of CBA from 1981 to 1993. Subsequently, he served on the Board as a District Representative until 2016. After that, he served as an Honorary Trustee. I want to personally thank Brother William for his lifetime commitment to CBA and the guidance and wisdom that he shared with me during my Chairmanship.

I again want to thank everyone in the CBA community for making CBA a place that we are all proud of. Our work is never done, so please continue to support CBA in any way that you can.

Lucas Weaver '07 and his wife Kaitlin welcomed their baby boy, Bo Weaver, to the family in June 2023. Congratulations!



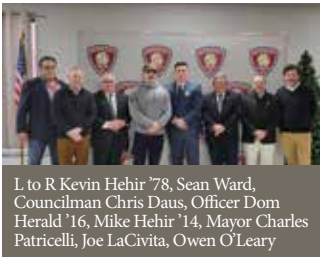
