We thank her, wish her well in retirement, and look forward


to the great work continuing with Matt Agan and the IA team.

# BOARD MEMBER FAREWELL

## JOSEPH A. REILLY '56

Since 2010, Joe has been a long-standing member of the CBA Board of Trustees. He has been an integral part in the success of the Christian Brothers Academy through his leadership and stewardship. Joe's illustrious career in radio includes serving as the President & CEO of the New York State Broadcasters Association where he represented the interests of more than 750 radio and television stations in the Empire State. Before joining the Association Joe founded, co-owned and operated a dozen broadcast properties in Virginia, Pennsylvania and New York. Among his many achievements was his leadership of the battle to open New York State's courts to camera and microphones which ended in 1987 when Governor Mario Cuomo signed into law the landmark bill.



In addition to Christian Brothers Academy, Joe has served on the Boards of the Broadcasters Foundation of America; the Teresian House of Albany, Capital Bank & Trust Company, the Albany Sons of St. Patrick; the NYS Partnership; Chase Lincoln First Bank, The Governors Telecommunications Exchange; the Governor's Committee for a Healthier NY; the New York State Youth Advisory Board; and the Advisory Board of Straus Digital Media.

His many awards include induction into the New York Broadcaster's Hall of Fame, CBA's Distinguished Alumnus

Award, the Empire State Society of Association Executives "Distinguished Member" award, the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences Silver Circle Award, NY Chapter. In 2007 two hubs of Siena College's broadcasting program were dedicated as the Joseph A. and Carol M. Reilly Broadcast Centers in recognition of his work and in memory of his wife. Most recently Joe sponsored the Buses and Vans at Christian Brothers Academy in support of our most recent Facility & Field Campaign.

## LYNN ZIELINSKI

Lynn has had a seat on our Board of Trustees since 2014 and served CBA with a strong focus on Academics and Music, which coincides with her background in teaching and love of music. Lynn's association with CBA began through her husband Gene, an alumnus from the class of 1958.

When she first joined the Board Lynn stated "Thirty-five years ago, I sat in Blecker Stadium on a cold night. I watched the game but I was more intrigued with the



fans and the family-like atmosphere they exhibited. Like my new husband, many were CBA alumni. They became one voice that night. All united, no matter their age, in a tradition of support to their school team and each proud to be a part of a whole that encompassed the prestigious Catholic school. I then realized that this was just routine for the Brothers Boys; just another game; just another chance to come together as one very special group. I felt that night that I was about to become a part of something very special, too!

My husband, Gene, and I have been fortunate to attend many functions and each event proved to me that the administration and staff continue to take great pride in giving an amazing education to each and every student. I have been a teacher for 33 years and I am amazed at how much maturity the young students possess. They all seem to have a much better sense of their self-worth than most young men of the same age.

Over the years, I have watched Gene and his friends/ classmates raise money to support CBA in any way they could. There is such a true commitment to CBA with an overwhelming sense of community and of family. I have become part of that wonderful family. It is with a deep sense of gratitude and purpose that I now serve on the Board of Trustees for CBA. A while ago, Gene and I felt the need to make CBA part of our legacy to help CBA continue in the tradition of a true Catholic education for the young men of our area."

Lynn and Gene have supported so many initiatives at CBA, among them are the building of our Music Suite, creation of the Teacher of the Year award, sponsored the installation of a stained glass window from the old school to be installed near the chapel in memory of her mother, and created the Zielinski Senior Music Award given to an outstanding senior student musician. They have left an incredible mark on CBA, one of which our community is very grateful.

## WRESTLING

The 2023-24 wrestling season saw over 60 young men in grades 5-12 take up the challenge. Through the hard work and discipline of these athletes, CBA Wrestling took huge strides in the growth of the program. The introduction of the 5th and 6th grade 'Little Brothers' level now provides an opportunity for our youngest athletes to start their wrestling journey with seven in the inaugural season. This season also featured the return of a full slate of dual meets for the first time in 10 years. The schedule included three home matches on brand new mats. The Brothers went 6-0 this season in those competitions. Three wrestlers finished with over 25 individual wins: **Marcus Burgos '25**, **Damian Tebano '26**, and **Luca Popolizio '27**. These three and **Freshman Nic Mello** earned bids to compete in the Section II State Qualifier, the first foursome to accomplish this at CBA since 2010. **Marcus Burgos '25** (5th), **Damian Tebano '26** (4th) and **Luca Popolizio '27** (2nd) all placed with Popolizio qualifying to compete in the State Tournament. This season's Wrestler of the Year, Popolizio accumulated a total season record of 37-6 with 27 by fall and a regular season record of 30-3. Over that span he took 1st in all 4 regular season non dual meet tournaments as well as the Class B Championships (first Class B Champ since 2007). He also became the first wrestler to represent CBA in the State Championships since 2007 and only the second 9th grader to accomplish this in CBA history. With only four seniors graduating (**Drew Loucks**, **Harry Corbin IV**, **Jack Miglucci** and **Asif Alam**), the future is bright for this young and exciting program.

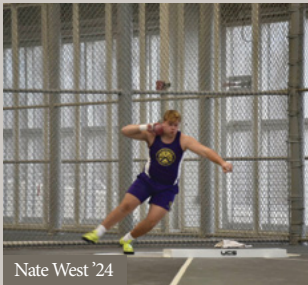

He joined the baseball coaching staff in 2013 and worked his way up to lead the Brothers to a Sectional Championship win in 2021. In February of 2023, Casey was diagnosed with rectal cancer but was still determined to be the coach and remained focused on achieving a Sectional title again. He continued to show strength, courage and resilience throughout the 2023 and 2024 seasons. His positivity was unmatched and he always put the interests of the kids first over what he was dealing with on a daily basis. He showed up to as many practices and games as he physically could, with his last being the Sectional Semifinals against Shenendehowa this past April. 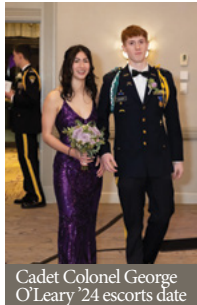

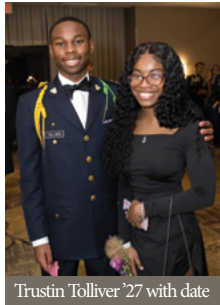

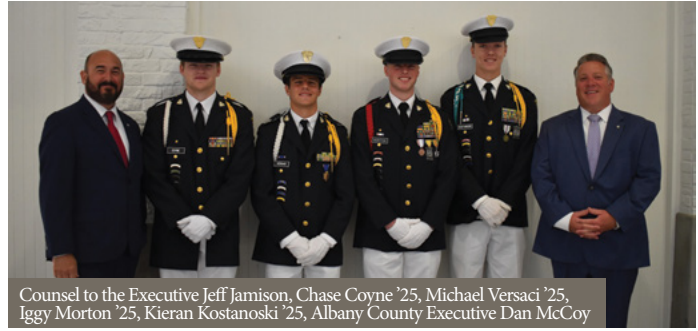

# THE DOME OPENING

In 2015, CBA embarked on its first ever capital campaign in which we renovated classrooms, the lecture hall, all of our science labs, and added a new wing to the school that includes a new engineering lab, a music suite, and new classrooms. Those rooms provided a wing dedicated to our sixth grade and the first ever class of fifth grade students, who are now members of our senior class. We intentionally chose a purely academic facilities campaign.

With the understanding that a CBA education is one of the mind, body, and spirit, in 2020, we announced our Facility & Field Campaign; a two-phase, \$4 million dollar campaign that would ultimately expand the CBA student experience. Through the tireless work of our Campaign Chair **Will Anthony '81**, Honorary Chair **Don 'Dice' Crotty '56**, immediate past Board of Trustee Chairman **Chris Scaringe '82** and our amazing Facility & Field Campaign committee members, our first phase was completed in 2022. This included the installation of the turf field, scoreboard and press box in the Puleo Stadium, which our students and athletes have been able to enjoy over the last three years.

On April 19, 2024 we officially completed phase two: The Dome. This facility is the first of its kind for a school in this area, one

more thing that sets CBA apart from other schools in the Capital Region. The 70,000 sq ft dome is designed to benefit all CBA students year-round; from JROTC to Marching Band to Athletics. With a covered field and court for basketball, baseball, football, soccer and lacrosse; space for JROTC drills and formation, band and PE classes. Plus a 200-meter, 4-lane track, sprint track, batting cage, golf simulator, weight room and wrestling area. The Dome will benefit CBA students for years to come. Through the generous support of **Karen and Frank Willey '71** and their lead gift, we are able to complete the Dome Campaign and we are honored to have this building bear their name: **The Karen and Frank Willey '71 Dome**.

Thank you to our CBA community and everyone who had a part in seeing the Dome come to fruition: our generous major sponsors whose naming plaques and banners you can see throughout the school campus and inside the Dome, the Facility & Field Campaign Committee, our Board of Trustees, facilities staff, administration, faculty and staff, alumni, and families. The Dome will benefit CBA students for years to come. This community, this family, continuously proves that both statements are true and that Christian Brothers Academy lives in our Hearts, Forever!

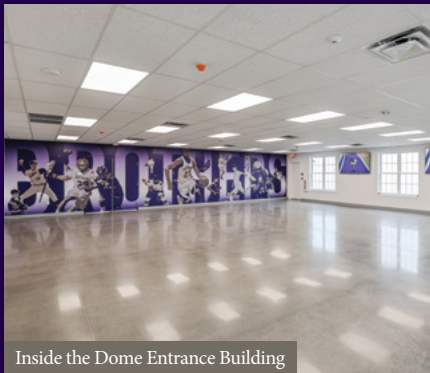

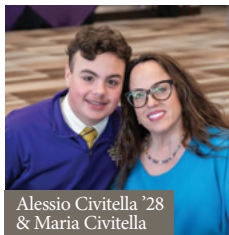
### JROTC FITNESS COMPETITION

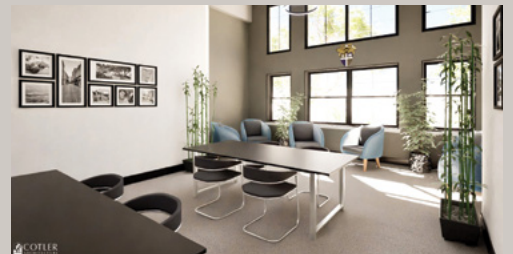
### MOTHER SON COMMUNION BRUNCH

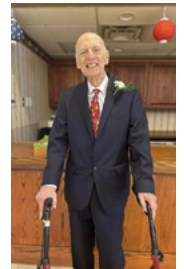

## ALUMNI FEATURE: FORT JOHNSON EXPERIENCE

On June 13, 2023, Fort Polk, located in Vernon Parish, Louisiana, was renamed to Fort Johnson in tribute to Medal of Honor recipient and Albany native and hero, Sgt. Henry Johnson. Fort Polk, previously named for a Confederate commander, Leonidas Polk, was renamed as part of an executive order to remove, rename and rebrand any and all military installations which bore the name of confederate leadership. This effort, put forth to celebrate the contributions of the vast diverse backgrounds which make up the United States armed forces and bring recognition to those heroes who had not always been celebrated and honored in a timely fashion and with the appropriate, dignified way.

Fort Polk, now Fort Johnson has historically worn the reputation and slogan “Home of Heroes”. The installation is known for its tough climate, unruly terrain and training regiment which is said to separate an everyday soldier from a hero. Fort Johnson was established on January 10, 1941. Thousands of Soldiers learned the basics of combat here during the World War II Louisiana Maneuvers. Forty-eight of the Army’s 91 divisions of WWII trained at Camp Polk (Johnson). Generals such as Eisenhower, Patton, Bradley and Marshall learned many lessons during the maneuvers that were critical to their success in defeating the axis powers. As such, after learning of the heroics of Sgt. Henry Johnson and the battle he single handedly fought and won in saving his comrades, the executive order was passed to rename Fort Polk to Fort Johnson in recognition of a true American Hero. In addition to this, Fort Johnson has the distinction of being the only US military installation to be named for a non commissioned officer!

In addition to the 5 Generals, 2 Admirals, 15 Colonels, 27 Purple Heart recipients, 2 Senators, a host of active military personnel and a standing room only crowd announced to at over 10,000 - CBA alumni Ronnie Spratt '88 and Jelani Cowan '97 were present in representation of CBA's commitment to living the legacy of Sgt. Henry Johnson. In his speech given during the closing reception, Jelani spoke of our five Henry Johnson scholars by name and exemplified them as the heartbeat of tenacity and excellence exuded by Sgt. Johnson in the modern day via their commitment to excellence as a part of CBA's overall mission.

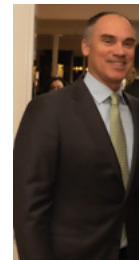

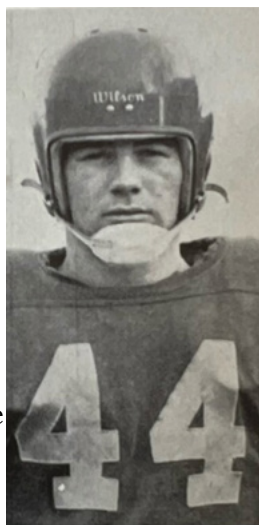

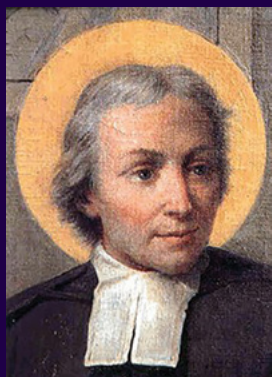
