

THOMAS DINOVO, ESQ.



Since 2011, Tom has been a long-standing member of the CBA Board of Trustees. A longtime supporter of CBA's mission and a valued voice on the Board, Tom has brought a deep sense of commitment, professionalism, and community spirit to his role. His sons, Thomas DiNovo '12 and Andrew DiNovo '17 are proud CBA graduates.

Outside of CBA, Tom is a highly respected partner in the Litigation department at O'Connell and Aronwitz, focusing almost exclusively on Personal Injury Litigation. He represents clients in complex matters involving serious injuries, product liability, and professional malpractice in both State and Federal

courts. Known for his attention to detail and thorough preparation, Tom has secured multiple multi-million dollar verdicts and settlements throughout New York and neighboring states. His expertise has earned him repeated recognition, including eight consecutive years on the Upstate New York Super Lawyers list and an AV-Preeminent rating from Martindale-Hubbell.

In addition to his legal work, Tom is deeply involved in the local community. He has served as general counsel to several emergency service organizations, provided continuing education programs for EMS and fire departments, and is a certified New York State Emergency Medical Technician. Tom has also been a regular lecturer and co-author on topics related to forensic engineering and expert witness testimony, as well as a frequent guest commentator on TALK 1300 AM. A dedicated advocate for youth and public safety, Tom has volunteered extensively with local little league organizations and presented safety programs to high school students as part of the national End Distracted Driving campaign.



CBA Bowling finished with a 5th place finish in the Suburban Council and 4th place at the Section 2 Tournament at Boulevard Bowl in Schenectady, NY. **Angelo Galofaro '26** led the Brothers all year. His consistency landed him a spot as a 1st Team League All Star. Angelo's performance in the Sectional Tournament earned him a spot in the NYS Tournament. **Tanner Walsh '27** and **Mike Scaccia '28** were also key contributors and made 2nd Team League All Stars. The Brothers are looking forward to rolling to victory next year.

WRESTLING

92.34 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

The 2024-2025 season marked a historic milestone for CBA Wrestling. In their inaugural year competing in the Suburban Council Blue Division, the varsity squad posted a 4-4 division record and an 8-6 overall dual meet record. Highlighting the season was CBA's first-ever dual meet victory over Shenendehowa.

The team made school history at the Class B tournament, where seven wrestlers placed—earning spots in the Section 2 State Qualifier. This marks the most Class B place finishers in program history, including three champions (**Marcus Burgos '25**, **Brody DiCaprio '27**, **Luca Popolizio '27**), one runner-up (**Damian Tebano '26**), one third-place (**Nic Mello '27**), one fifth-place (**Alex Diaz '26**) and a 6th place finisher (**Keegan Tan '26**).

The momentum continued as four wrestlers; **Brody DiCaprio '27**, **Luca Popolizio '27**, **Marcus Burgos '25**, and **Damian Tebano '26**, advanced to the New York State Championships at the Times Union Center. CBA led all Division 1 schools (large) with three Section 2 champions and had the second most total state qualifiers with four athletes. Notably, **Brody DiCaprio '27** became CBA's first State Place Finisher since 2007, earning 7th place.

Individual milestones added to the program's success: both **DiCaprio '27** and **Popolizio '27** surpassed the 100-win mark, while senior Marcus Burgos concluded an impressive career with 96 wins, a Sectional 2 title, and a trip to the State Championships. He was also honored with the Section 2 Wrestling Coaches Sportsmanship Award.





INDOOR TRACK & FIELD

Coming off their first-ever Sectional Championship in cross country, the CBA Track & Field team carried their momentum into the indoor season with remarkable success. They opened with a 3rd place team finish at the historic Bishop Loughlin Games in New York City, and **Jack Marchese '25** rang in the new year by breaking his own school record in the 1000m (2:30.89).

92.53 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

The Brothers continued their record-setting pace at the Yale Track Classic, where the 4x800m relay team of **Marchese '25**, **Michael Versaci '25**, **Wil Comensky '25**, and **Henry Gaylord '25** set a new school record of 8:02.52, earning them an invite to the prestigious Millrose Games, where they lowered the record again to 8:01. Back home, **Jacob Baker '25** set a new school record in the weight throw (60' 2.25"), winning the Section 2 Division 1 Championship. Other standout performances included **Jalen Chapman '26** (2nd in triple jump, 41') and **Versaci '25** (Sectional Champion in the 3200m at 9:49), helping the team place 4th overall at Sectionals.

At the State Championships, five Brothers competed: the 4x800 relay team and **Baker '25** in the weight throw. The relay finished 2nd in New York State, setting another school record (7:56.56), while Baker placed 10th overall. The team's indoor success continued at New Balance Nationals, where two more school records fell: a 10:31.23 Distance Medley Relay and Marchese's 800m title with a 1:55.94 finish. The Brothers continued their momentum with **Maverick Kentz '26** setting a new school record in the 3000m steeplechase (10:05.63), and **Max Kimball '27** cleared 6'6" in the high jump, earning a 2nd place finish at the NYSPHSAA Class B Championships.

HOCKEY 92.51 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

The CBA Hockey team made a strong statement in Coach Thomas Gaunay's first season behind the bench. The Brothers delivered a memorable winter campaign, capturing multiple tournament titles, including the prestigious Bill Corbett Memorial Tournament in Potsdam and the Cortland-Homer Holiday Tournament in Cortland.

Throughout the regular season, the Brothers showcased their trademark grit and determination, earning a home-ice advantage for the opening round of Sectionals. In that matchup against the CD Jets, Senior Captain Drew Mosier led the charge with a remarkable hat trick, powering CBA to a thrilling 3-2 victory. **Dom Waters '25** and **Aidan Donohue '26** were offensive standouts all season, consistently making their mark on the scoresheet. Waters' leadership and production earned him First Team All-League Honors, while Donohue's impressive junior campaign secured him a spot on the Second Team All-League.

With key contributors returning and the momentum of several big league and non-league wins behind them, the Brothers are eager to build on this season's success and continue their upward trajectory in the year ahead.





The 2025 CBA Baseball season was one marked by both heartfelt transition and resilience. Following the loss of Coach O'Connor to his courageous battle with cancer, the team entered the season playing not just for wins, but in honor of his legacy.

90.42 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

On the field, the Brothers faced their share of challenges, including key injuries and a young roster gaining much-needed experience. Despite these hurdles, the team laid a strong foundation for the future. The varsity squad was tested early with a demanding three-game road trip to Virginia, where they faced two eventual 2025 State Champions. Each senior played a crucial role in establishing the character and work ethic that will define CBA Baseball for years to come.

TENNIS 95.30 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

The CBA tennis team showed impressive growth as the season progressed. Competing in the highly competitive Suburban Council with a young roster, the Brothers embraced every match as a learning opportunity and steadily improved throughout the spring. **Hogan Molaro '26** led the way in the top singles spot, setting the tone for the team with strong leadership and competitive play.


With a solid core of returning players and valuable postseason experience under their belt, the Brothers are poised to build on this year's progress and make even greater strides in the 2026 season.

OUTDOOR TRACK & FIELD

92.41 ACADEMIC TEAM AVERAGE

Unpredictable spring weather in Upstate New York didn't slow down CBA Track & Field. Despite a rain-soaked regular season, the Brothers remained focused on major invitationals and postseason success. At the prestigious Eddy Meet, the Brothers delivered standout performances, including a second straight 4x800m relay title and a first-place triple jump by **Jalen Chapman '26** (46' 4"), helping the team finish 2nd overall out of 33+ teams—one of the best showings in New York State.

Momentum continued at the Section 2 Championships, where a strong team effort earned CBA 47 points and a 5th-place finish against the area's largest schools. Podium highlights included second-place finishes from the 4x800m relay, **Max Kimball '27** (high jump), **Jack Marchese '25** (800m), and a third place finish by **Jacob Baker '25** in the weight throw.

At State Qualifiers, seven Brothers earned their place at the NYS Championships in Middletown, with several

hitting state super standards earlier in the season. At States, the Brothers once again rose to the occasion:

Max Kimball '27 set the outdoor high jump school record at 6'6", placing 2nd in Class B and 5th overall.

Jalen Chapman '26 finished 4th in Class B triple jump (44'8.25").

Jacob Baker '25 placed 7th in shot put and 9th in discus.

The 4x800m relay (seniors **Jack, Wil, Henry, Michael**) earned 2nd in Class B (7:54.5).

The season closed on a high note at New Balance Nationals in Philadelphia, where the 4x800m relay broke the outdoor school record (7:52.9). Additionally, **Dominic LaPorta '30** ran an outstanding 2:05 in the 800m, ranking 6th nationally among 7th graders, and the Distance Medley Relay (**Jack, Michael, Henry**, and sophomore **Declan Lyman**) clocked a fast 10:30. Congratulations to Coach O'Malley and the entire CBA Track & Field program on a remarkable year!


Q What advice would you give to current CBA students or recent graduates interested in entrepreneurship?
