Nick Davey Named CBA Varsity Baseball Head Coach

Coach Davey officially joins the Varsity Baseball Program as Head Coach

(Albany, NY) - Christian Brothers Academy (CBA) has named Nick Davey as the new Varsity Baseball Head Coach. Coach Davey will be taking over the program this upcoming season following the passing of beloved Coach Casey O'Connor.

Coach Davey has been involved with baseball throughout the Capital Region for many years and has coached student athletes at a variety of levels. He was the assistant coach at Guilderland High School for four seasons under Coach Doug LaVallee, and the Pitching Coach and Recruiting Coordinator for the College of St. Rose for five years. More recently, he was the team manager of the Albany Dutchmen for thirteen seasons, where he coached 42 MLB Draft picks, including two who are currently in the major leagues. He also received the 2015 Perfect Game Coach of the Year with the Dutchmen.

Coach Davey joined the CBA Baseball program this past season overseeing pitchers. He said "I want to thank Dr. Schlegel, Blaine Drescher '04 our Director of Athletics, and my wife for fully supporting me as the next baseball coach at CBA. It's an honor to take over this program and build off of what Casey was able to do the last 10 years. He and his family have been dear friends and I'm ready to continue a rich tradition that was built by him and coaches like Dave Doemel '71 and Jim Pedlow '60. Casey will forever be missed and I will make sure we prepare as a program each and every day to play at a level that will make him proud."

He is going to provide our student athletes with the best opportunities not only to develop throughout high school, but put them on a path to success.
